New Exhibitions in 2019/2020 in the Haus der Geschichte

Very British! A German Point of View

10 July – March 2020

Beatles, Brexit, Buckingham Palace: the British royal family, pop music, legendary football matches and both World Wars have uniquely shaped German-English relations. From a German point of view, the exhibition “Very British!” looks at the historical, economic and cultural aspects of German-English relations, including the special role of Great Britain in Europe since 1945.

Hits and Hymns. Sounds of Contemporary History

May 2020 – January 2021

Music sparks emotions: it agitates, mobilizes and forges identity.

Commemorating the 250th birthday of Ludwig van Beethoven, the Haus der Geschichte explores the topic of music and politics; through the eyes of contemporary history it references the political artist that Beethoven indeed was.

Topics in the exhibition include a discussion about the national anthems in both German states, musical protest songs against the “Establishment” in the 1960s, GDR singer-songwriters as well as the current discussion surrounding the ECHO-Music Awards 2018.
